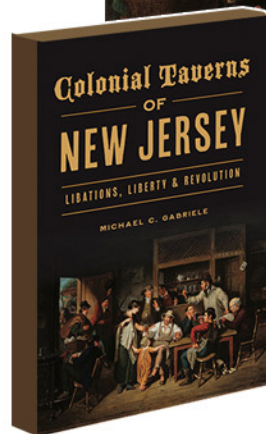
Michael C. Gabriele **‘Colonial Taverns of New Jersey’**
